Personal Photographs as a Screen Saver

1. Make sure you have two or more photos in a folder on your computer. I made up a folder called "My Screensaver Photos"
2. From the Desktop Click on "Start", then "Control Panel",
3. Double Click on "Display". On the "Display Properties " window, Click on "Screen Saver".
4. "My Pictures Screen Saver Options" window will be displayed (Figure 1.).
5. In the drop down menu scroll down to "My Pictures Slideshow" (Figure2.).
6. Click on "Settings", "My Pictures Screen Saver Options" will be displayed.
7. Click on "Browse" and navigate to the folder that you saved as your screen saver photos. In my case the folder was "My Screensaver Photos" (Figure 3.). After you have found your folder and it is selected Click "OK"
8. You will be returned to "My Pictures Screen Saver Options", Click "OK".
9. On the "Display Properties" window, set the wait time, then Click "Apply". You now can preview the screen saver or Click "OK" to finish.

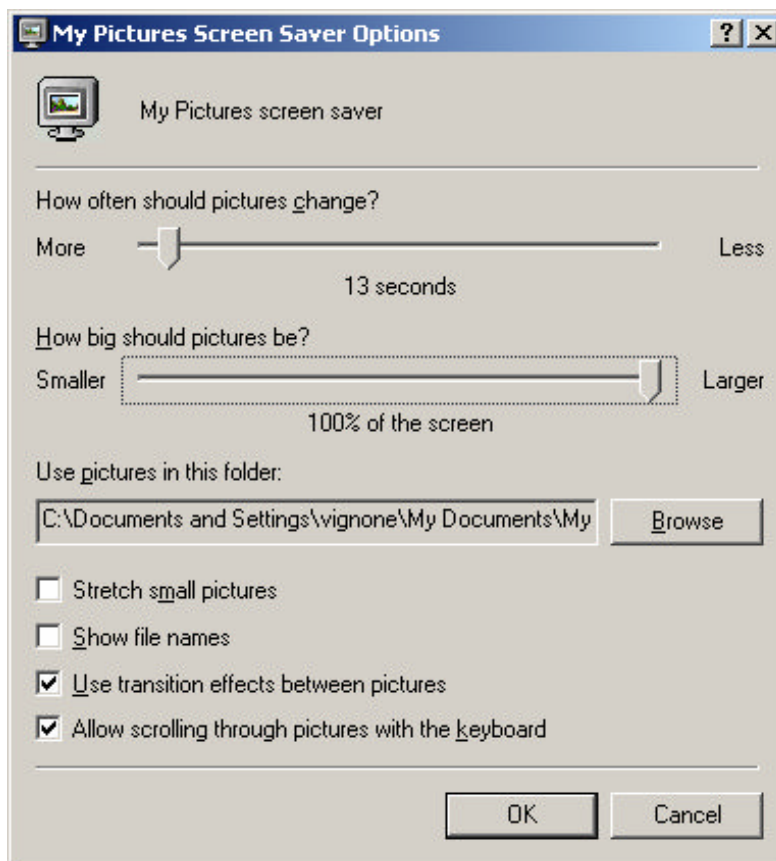

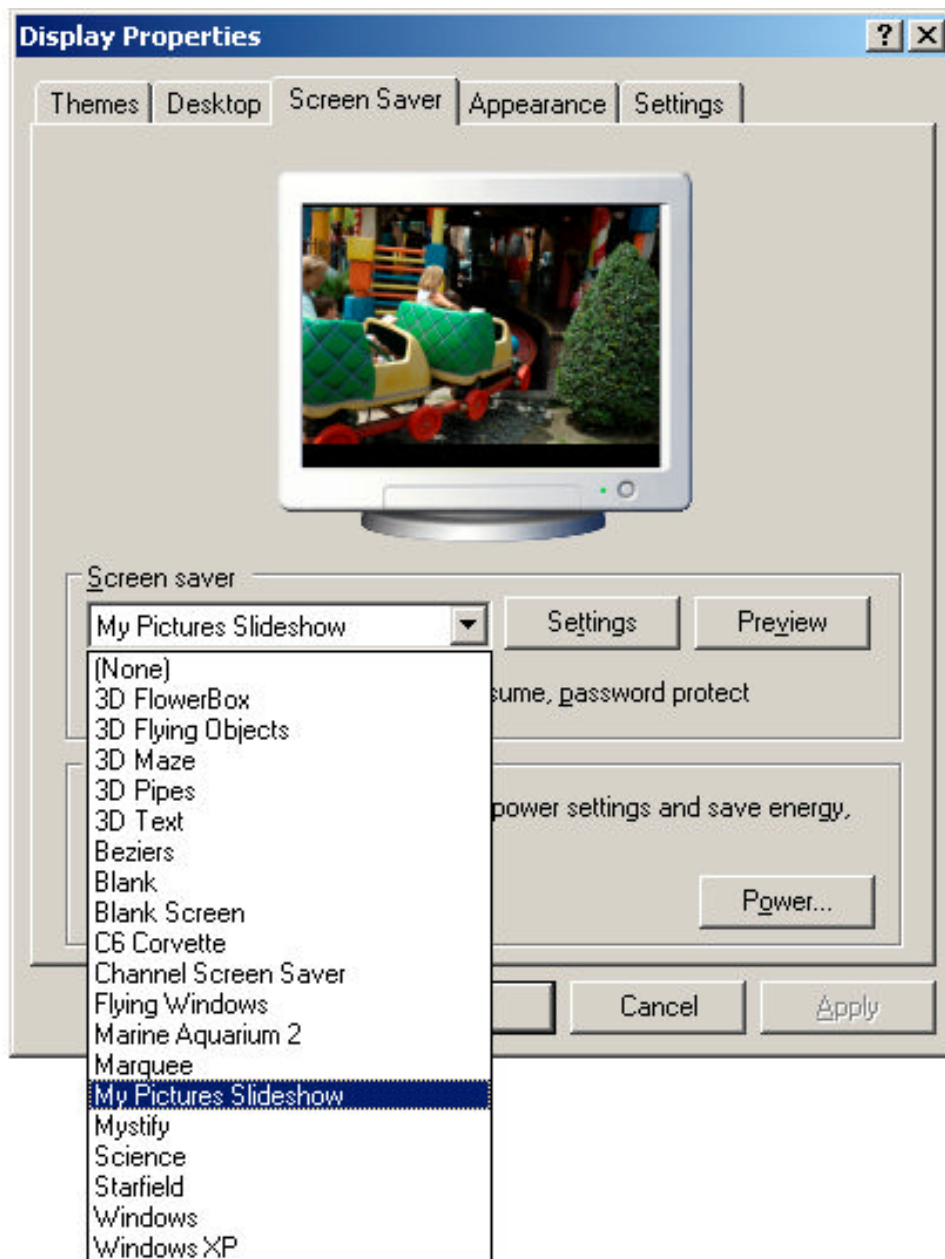

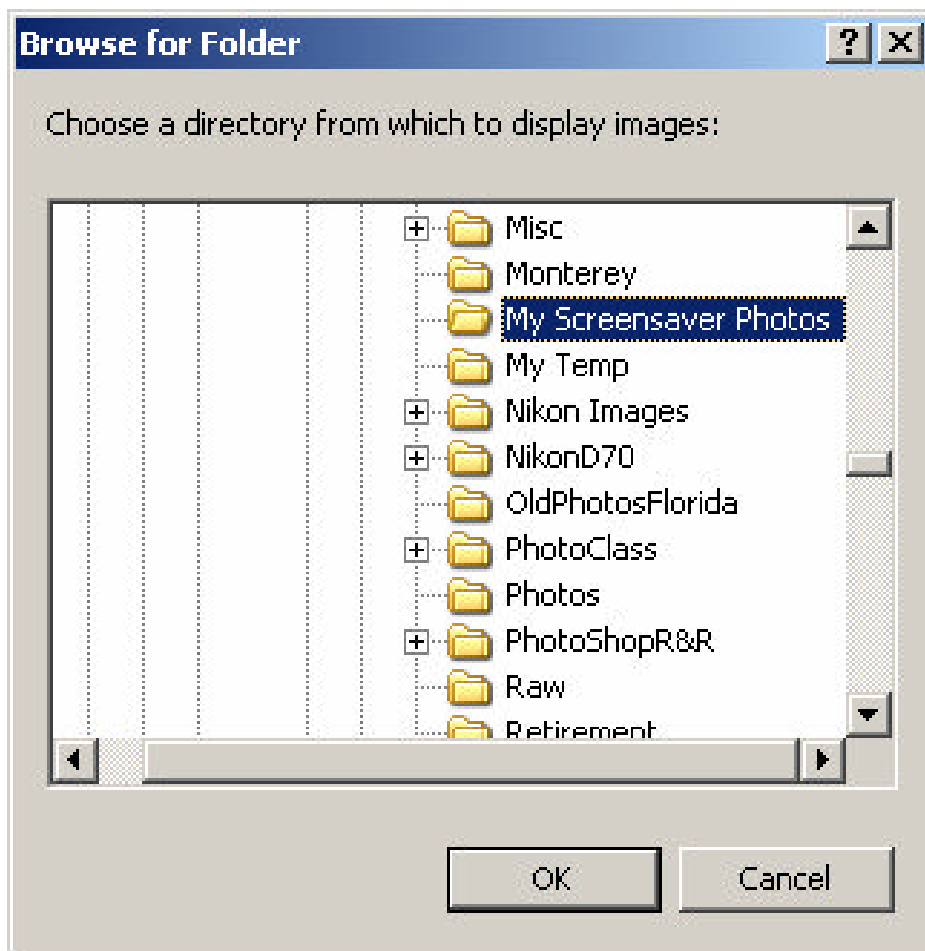
